

## INVESTIGATIVE CONSUMER REPORT NOTIFICATION

In compliance with public Law 91-508, an investigative consumer report may be made within the next few days which will provide applicable and relevant material concerning character, general reputation, personal characteristics and mode of living. This report will be obtained through personal interviews with friends, neighbors, and associates. Upon written request to Trustmark Insurance Company, a complete and accurate disclosure of the nature, source and scope of the investigative consumer report, if one is made, will be provided.

Information regarding your insurability will be treated as confidential. Trustmark Insurance Company or its reinsurers may, however, make brief report thereon to the Medical Information Bureau, a non-profit membership organization of life insurance companies, which operates an informational exchange on behalf of its members. If you apply to another Bureau member company for life or health insurance coverage, or a claim for benefits is submitted to such company, the Bureau, upon request, will supply such company with the information on its file.

Upon receipt of request from you, the Bureau will arrange disclosure of any information it may have on file. (Medical information will be disclosed only to your attending physician.) If you question the accuracy of information in the Bureau's file, you may contact the Bureau and seek a correction in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Federal Fair Credit Reporting Act. Trustmark Insurance Company or its reinsurers may also release information in its file to other life insurance companies to whom you may apply for life or health insurance, or to whom a claim for benefits may be submitted.
